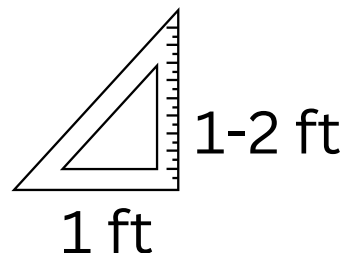

Beautiful evergreen foliage topped by racemes of showy white flowers in summer. This orchid is native to dry to mesic woodlands, bluffs, wooded slopes, and wooded ravines in the Eastern US. It is relatively easy to grow in a woodland garden in dappled shade and rich soil. Mulch for consistent moisture.
