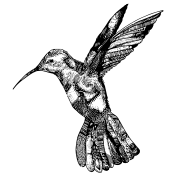
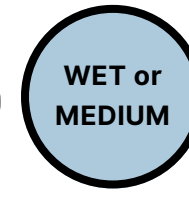


Mertensia virginica

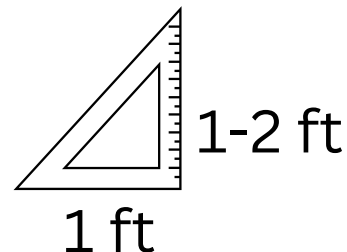
Virginia Bluebells



Spring ephemeral native to moist woodland areas in the Mid-Atlantic. This plant prefers to live under deciduous trees (winter sun and summer shade) in moist rich humusy soils with good drainage.

Rabbit resistant.

Sometimes deer resistant.



Wildlife Value: The flowers attract bumblebees, long-tongued bees, butterflies, skippers, moths, and hummingbirds. Provides nectar for the Cabbage White, Red Admiral, and Painted Lady butterflies.
