
Oenothera fruticosa Sundrops




Sundrops is a day-flowering member of the evening primrose family. Red buds turn into yellow floers over a long period. It prefers moderately fertile, dry, well-drained soil in full sun but will tolerate some shade. Good winter drainage is essential. It can spread quickly forming a semi-evergreen groundcover.

Deer will eat flowers.



Wildlife Value: Hummingbirds nectar at the flowers and songbirds eat the seeds. Supports specialized bee *Lasioglossum oenotherae*.
