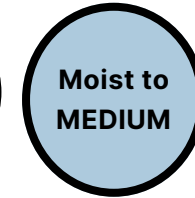

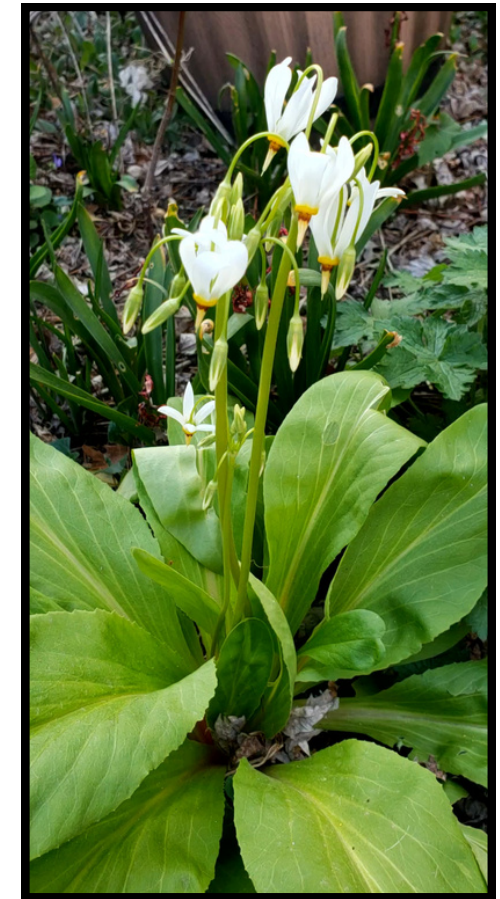
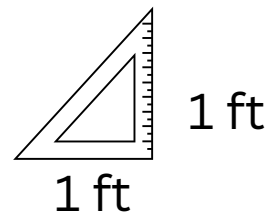
E. Shooting Star



Shooting Star is a native N. American spring ephemeral with unusual blooms in a shooting star-like appearance. They grow best in moist, humusy well-drained soil in part shade. Avoid poorly drained sites. By mid-summer, the foliage disappears and the plant goes dormant.
