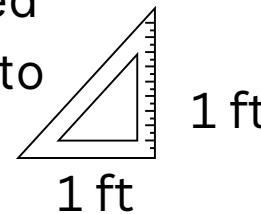


# *Trillium erectum*

## Red Trillium



Trillium are a quintessential woodland spring ephemeral. This red 3-petaled flower is above the large green bracts. Red Trillium prefers to live under deciduous trees (with summer shade and winter sun) in moist, rich, humusy soils with good drainage. Suitable for wooded or naturalized areas. It is very cold hardy but is sensitive to heat.



**Wildlife Value:** Bees and other pollinating insects enjoy the nectar from the flowers. Moths use this plant as a larval host. Birds and small mammals enjoy the berries as a food source.
