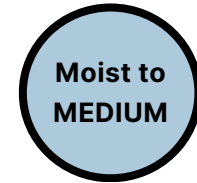


Uvularia grandiflora

Merrybells (or Bellwort)



Spring ephemeral, easily grown in average, medium, well-drained soil under a deciduous tree (part to full shade in summer, sun in winter). Prefers a moist, humusy soil. It is a clump-forming, erect plant that grows to 2' tall and features drooping bell-shaped, yellow flowers. Occurs in the wild typically in rich woodlands, on wooded slopes and in alluvial valleys.
